Bethany, July 21. Celebrating Mission, Schools and Congregations. Reverend Volker Dally, Director of the Leipzig Mission, will preach at Bethany at 8.45 and 11am on 21 July, followed by a Community Lunch at 12.30. It is a great privilege to welcome Rev. Dally in this year of our 175th anniversary as the Dresden/Leipzig was intimately involved in establishing our Lutheran Church in southern Australia. Four of our six Pastors came from this Mission School, with instructions to undertake Mission work among our Indigenous People and to form supporting congregations among the Lutherans already in SA.. Schurmann and Teichelmann arrived in 1838 and established a school at Piltawodli (North Adelaide) and further schools were established at Victor Harbour (Pr Meyer) and Port Lincoln (Pr Schurmann), during which time these Missionaries recorded the language and customs of the local indigenous peoples which are now so important in our moves towards reconciliation. Pr Meyer accepted a call to Bethany and was involved with establishment of 12 congregations, following the agricultural frontier as far north as Carlsruhre. Pr Schurmann went to western Victoria and 150 years ago the two synods united to undertake mission work at Killalpinanna and Hermansburg.

This celebration at Bethany is an opportunity to look forward as a Church to the challenges which we face following Christ's instructions and an opportunity to acknowledge our history. Come to Bethany on Sunday 21 July to celebrate and contribute.
