### [3] Unique protagonists:

What is this Book about? Who are the main actors? Two types.

[1] The Triune God.

Choosing of Israel – His Son (Ex 4:22). To witness. Daniel 3:28-4:3. Daniel 6:25-28. Esther 9:29-32. Acts 15:21.

Sending His true Son to be our Redeemer.

[2] Us. Humanity. How do we want to portray our heroes?

What are we like in the Bible? The story of sin and unfaithfulness. But also, of God's work in us through His Holy Spirit.

[What does this mean for us? What does it teach about our relationships with the Triune God? How do we come Him? Not with our goodness, but with our honesty.]

What does it reveal about Adam? (Gen 2-4). Free will? Really?

What does it reveal about Abraham? Pimp. Gen 12:10-20, Gen 20. Righteous. 15:6. Prayer. Gen 18, 20:7. Sacrifice of Isaac Genesis 22.

What does it reveal about Moses (Ex 2:11-12, 4:1f. Num 12.)

What does it reveal about David? 1 Sam 16:7, 2 Sam 11-12.

What does it reveal about Apostles? Luke 9:51f, Matt 20:20f., Matt 26:30-35. John 20:19, etc.

Who will we see? Who will we meet and live with forever?
